These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the **City of Dickinson**.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about **July 2, 2020**, the **City of Dickinson**, will submit a request to the General Land Office (GLO) for the release of Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery funds under the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2018, and Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Act, 2017 (Public Law 115-56) to undertake a project known as **Dickinson - Nicholstone - 20-065-029-C-096 - Street-Drainage-EA for the purpose of improving surface transportation and roadside drainage in an area of the City which was damaged by a hurricane**.

Description of Project:

Street and Drainage Facilities

Subrecipient shall provide improved surface transportation and roadside drainage by clearing roadside ditches, installing culverts with associated pavement repair, and completing associated appurtenances. The project will address 6,400 LF of roadway and construction will include the removal of 15,500 SY of asphalt pavement, removal and replacement of 3,750 CY of base material and earthwork, removal of 1,650 LF of existing culverts, installation of 15,500 SY of 6” reinforced concrete pavement and 2,700 SY of 6” reinforced concrete driveways and installation of 1,650 LF of driveway culverts.

Location:

All work will occur in the City of Dickinson, Galveston County, Texas in the following locations:

Flood and Drainage Facilities

- Kansas Ave from 29th St. to 38th St.
- Texas Ave from 29th to 38th St.
- Colorado Ave from 28th St. to 30th St.
- 30th St. from Dickinson Ave. to California Ave.
- 32nd St. from Dickson Ave to California Ave
- 34th St. from Dickson Ave to California Ave

- 38th St. from Dickson Ave to California Ave
- 39th St. from Texas Ave. to California Ave.
- 43rd St.. from Galveston Ave. west approximately 693 l.f. to end

Project Issues: Floodplains and Historic Preservation: A full, detailed list of mitigation measures can be found in the Environmental Review Record.

Project size: Approximately 5.9 acres.

Total Grant Amount: Project will cost \$8,982,434 and will be paid for with \$8,982,434 in HUD CDBG-DR grant funds administered by the General Land Office.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The **City of Dickinson** has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the **Dickinson City Hall, 4403 Highway 3, Dickinson, Texas 77539** and may be examined or copied weekdays 9 A.M to 4 P.M.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to **Mayor, Dickinson City Hall, 4403 Highway 3, Dickinson, Texas 77539**. All comments received by **July 1, 2020** or within eighteen (18) days following this posting (whichever is later) will be considered by the **City of Dickinson** prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which part of this Notice they are addressing.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The **City of Dickinson** certifies to GLO that **Julie Masters** in their capacity as **Mayor** consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. GLO's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the **City of Dickinson** to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

GLO will accept objections to its release of funds and the **City of Dickinson's** certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the **City of Dickinson**; (b) the **City of Dickinson** has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by GLO; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to the Community Development and Revitalization Program, General Land Office at Texas Disaster Recovery Program 1700 N. Congress, Austin, TX 78701. Potential objectors should contact GLO to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
