

ORDINANCE NUMBER 959-2020

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DICKINSON, TEXAS, EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF DISASTER ISSUED BY MAYORAL PROCLAMATION ON JUNE 28, 2020 AND EXTENDED BY CITY COUNCIL THROUGH ORDINANCE 958-2020 ON JULY 2, 2020 IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19.

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2020, Julie Masters, Mayor of the City of Dickinson, Texas, issued a Mayoral Proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City of Dickinson to alleviate the suffering of people and to prevent the spread of COVID-19 throughout the City of Dickinson; and

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2020, the City Council of the City of Dickinson, Texas passed, approved, and adopted Ordinance 958-2020 extending the disaster declaration through August 4, 2020, as authorized by Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating such disaster declaration continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to prevent the spread of COVID-19 throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 418.108(b), Texas Government Code, a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven (7) days without the consent of the governmental body of the political subdivision;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DICKINSON, TEXAS:

Section 1. The declaration disaster, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on June 28, 2020, and extended by City Council through August 4, 2020, shall hereby be renewed and extended for seventy (70) days through October 13, 2020, as authorized by Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.


